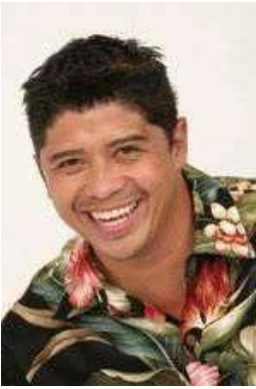

Augie T



Augie was born in 1968 and is the second oldest of six children. He grew up in the Kamehameha IV Housing Project (known to Hawaii residents as "Kam IV Housing") in Kalihi Valley. He began doing comedy in high school after a teacher forced him to enter speech contests. In the first contest he simply did a verbatim recitation of Rap Reiplinger's *Room Service*. "I won," he recalls. "I won every school speech contest in high school."

Augie got his first taste of stand-up comedy, taking top honors during an open mic night at the old Honolulu Comedy Club. Augie developed his earliest material with help from Andy Bumatai, who taught him that it isn't always necessary to use profanity to get a laugh.

Augie won the Nā Hōkū Hanohano Award for Comedy Album of the Year with "Da Comedy Kahuna" in 1999. He won a second award in the comedy category with "Locally Disturbed" in 2003. "I want to be the contemporary moke, but at the same time show a different side," he says. "I'm the blue-collar comic, the working man, the guy you can relate to."

In 2002, Augie was voted Comedian of the Year as the funniest comic in Hawai'i by the Honolulu Star-Bulletin and MidWeek newspapers. He is the only local comedian to sell out the Blaisdell Arena ("Augie T. - The Blaisdell Arena Show" DVD) and is recognized as one of Hawai'i's Top 100 Influential Filipinos with an exhibit at the Bishop Museum.

These days, in addition to headlining events throughout the islands, Augie spends time working for various community organizations, such as B.R.A.V.E., (Be Respectful and Value Everyone), a foundation started by his daughter, Mahealani. He also recently participated in the HSTA Social Justice Summit, the Hele for Autism walk, and more.

He says, "Some of the most rewarding work I do is fundraising and speaking to make a positive difference in our Hawaii communities. I feel blessed to use my ability to make people laugh to help schools, clubs, and organizations across the state. These efforts get a big boost from my generous sponsors."
